

## **Our Newest Venture**

Since the final Laura's March in September 2016, we have been considering how the LKW Fund would continue to have a significant impact on the Burlington community. We are thrilled to announce our biggest project to date: the creation of the Laura Kate Winterbottom Art Therapy Center at the Integrated Arts Academy at the H.O. Wheeler School in Burlington's Old North End.

The LKW Art Therapy Center offers the opportunity to combine our 2 missions: to prevent sexual and domestic violence and to support enrichment programs for disadvantaged children, and promises to be a paradigm in therapeutic and transformative arts education.

Getting the LKW Art Therapy Center started, sustaining it and expanding to include more and more students will require a substantial financial commitment. With donations and in-kind contributions from an architect and contractors, we have commitments to date covering about 60% of construction and the first year operating costs. We hope you will consider making a tax deductible donation to help us develop this program as well as continue to work on and support other projects.

The Old North End is one of the most impoverished areas in New England. Many IAA students are very vulnerable in that they come from generational poverty or are refugees, and may have experienced complex trauma from exposure to sexual, physical or substance abuse, war, violence, and acculturation.

One of the key elements in preventing abusive and violent behavior is early intervention. Art therapy is a powerful intervention tool that enables at-risk children to explore their feelings, express themselves in a healthy manner, and develop socially appropriate skills and behavior. Art therapy has the capacity to change the trajectory of the lives of disaffected children. It can provide a channel for positive transformation and growth. (The picture above is a sample of the art that children are already creating at IAA.) As Pablo Picasso noted: "Art washes from the soul the dust of everyday life."
